

Steps to developing an EVALUATION PLAN



Step 1: Why are you evaluating?

- Identify evaluation objectives and goals
- Identify audience and stakeholders



Step 2: What is being evaluated?

- Select evaluation design
- Develop evaluation questions



Step 3: What will you measure?

- Identify outcomes
- Identify indicators



Step 6: What will I do with the data?

- Develop a data analysis strategy
- Develop a reporting/ dissemination strategy



Step 5: Who will you collect data from?

- Determine sample
- Consider ethics



Step 4: How will you measure it?

- Select data sources and data collection methods



Step 7: How much will this cost?

- Develop a budget



Step 8: Who will do what?

- Determine roles and responsibilities



Step 9: How long will this take?

- Develop timelines
