STATBOX Medication List

Statbox items are intended for immediate/emergency use and should be followed with patient specific product as required.

Each Type A Home should carry one main statbox of the required items, and may add the non-required stock items at the Home's discretion.

Additional smaller satellite statboxes may be necessary on specific units, depending on the size and needs of the LTC Home.

Minimal quantities should be kept on hand to avoid overstock: 5-15 doses for solid oral dosage forms, 1-2 units of other items.
